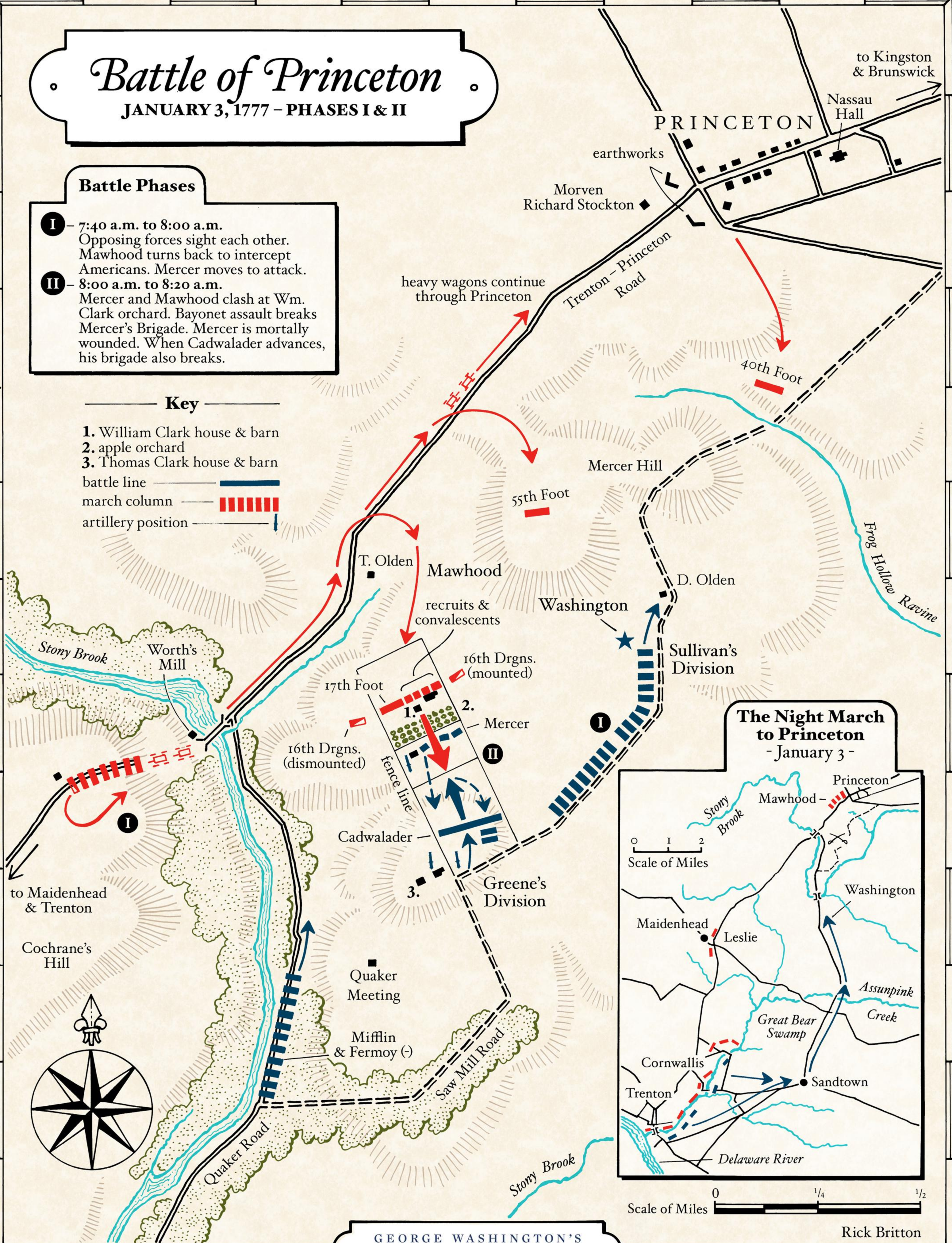
JANUARY 3, 1777 - PHASES I & II

Battle Phases

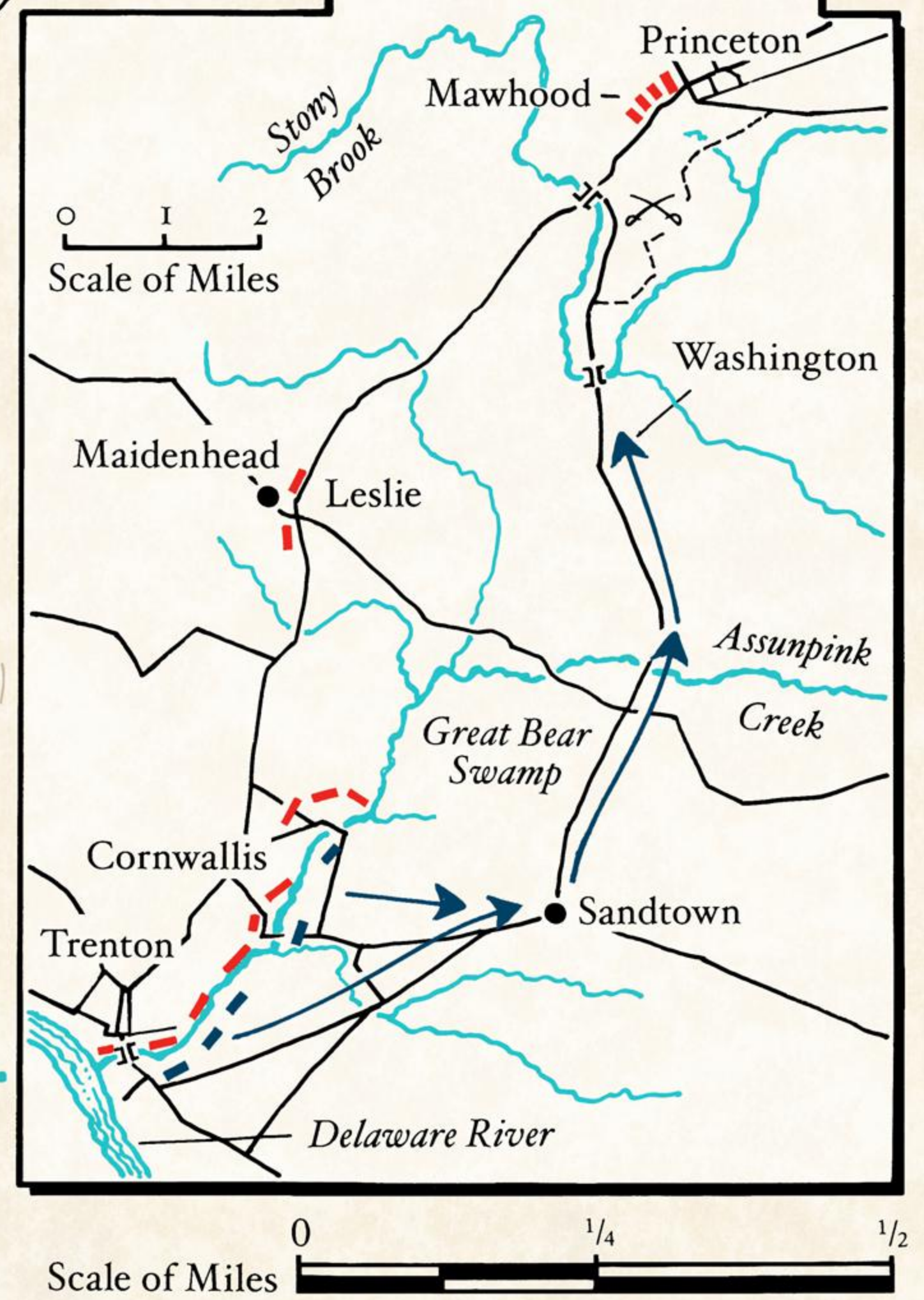
- I** - 7:40 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.
Opposing forces sight each other. Mawhood turns back to intercept Americans. Mercer moves to attack.
- II** - 8:00 a.m. to 8:20 a.m.
Mercer and Mawhood clash at Wm. Clark orchard. Bayonet assault breaks Mercer's Brigade. Mercer is mortally wounded. When Cadwalader advances, his brigade also breaks.
